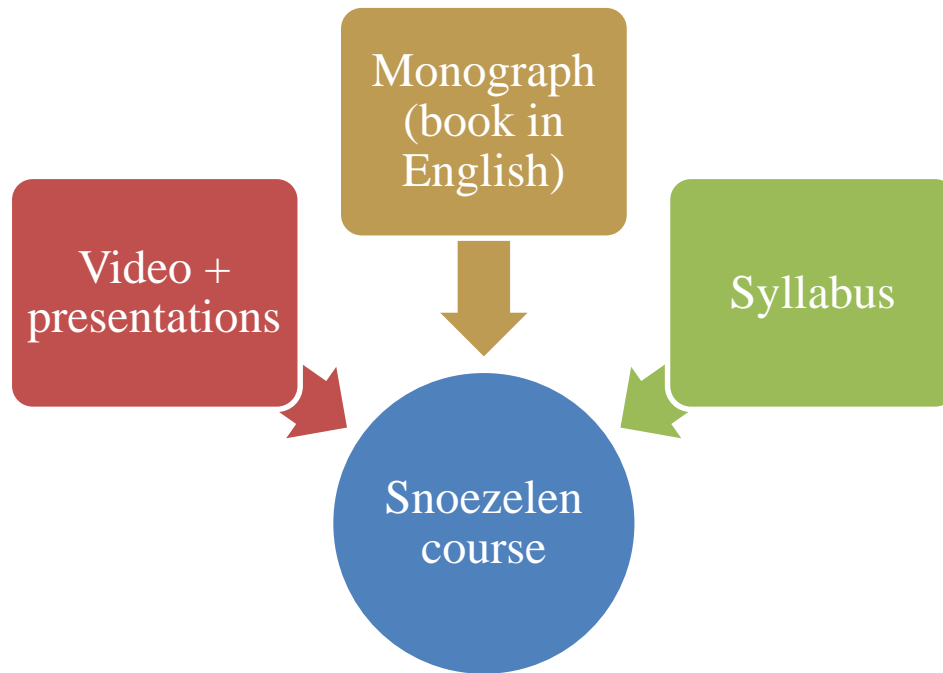

to prepare a comprehensive instructional methodology and a syllabus of the course "Snoezelen" at an international tertiary-educational level (so that the course is applicable in an international student mobility).

Project outputs:

- a) publishing a **monograph** and **individual scientific papers** dealing with these issues;
- b) **creating videos** and a **set of additional case studies** as an example of the practical part of the course;
- c) designing the "Snoezelen" course for student mobilities.





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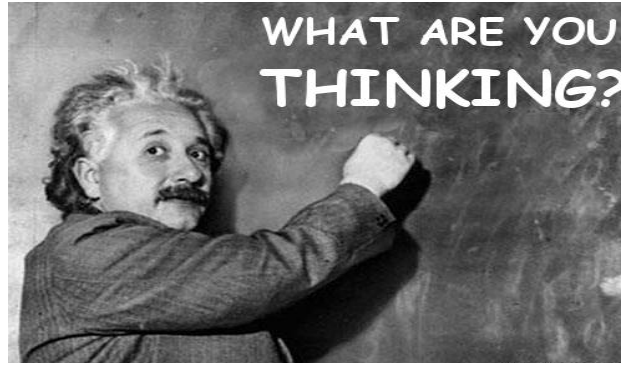
**The way to achieve our main aim and outputs leads

MULTIPLIER EVENTS:

Local activities held at each university with min. 25 persons during the project duration twice (in March 2022 and June 2023):

- Workshop for professionals and those interested in Snoezelen I.:

The aim is to introduce theoretical base of Snoezelen as well as to demonstrate working in multisensory rooms not only to professionals but also for those interested in this concept. Workshop participants can be employees of universities as well as other experts, social workers and the public.

- Workshop for professionals and those interested in Snoezelen II.:

The aim is to present the project outcomes, publish the created materials of specific character and spread the information of the innovative subject of Snoezelen.



Project activity types:

4. LEARNING, TEACHING AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES (C1-6) (pink)

- C1 – May 2021, SU (Short-term joint staff training events, 3days)
- C2 – January 2022, UdL (Short-term joint staff training events, 3days)
- C3+C4 – June 2022, SU (Intensive programmes for teaching staff + Intensive programmes for higher education learners)
- C5+6 – May 2023, AWF (Intensive programmes for teaching staff + Intensive programmes for higher education learners)

LEARNING, TEACHING AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES

- **C1 – Special educational context of Snoezelen (for 3 participants from SU, 3 participants from AWF, 2 participants from UdL, 3 days in Opava)**
- **C2 – Psychological and pedagogical contexts of Snoezelen (the same participants, the same 3 days in Lleide)**

C1 and C2 are brief trainings of participants of the project which aim at gaining new experience in a partner team environment.

- **C3 + C4 – ISNA –MSE COURSE (An intensive programme for students, teachers, experts etc., 5 days in Opava)**

An intensive course - speakers will be chosen from the board team of ISNA – MSE. At the end of the course participants will receive certificates of the course.

- **C5 + C6 – Therapeutical approaches to Snoezelen (An intensive programme for students, teachers, experts etc., 5 days, AWF)**

The goal is to gain a wider range of information concerning methods of therapeutic and rehabilitation focus which form another group of possible strategies usable in multisensory rooms. The course will be led by appointed experts on certain topics. At the end of the course participants will receive certificates of the course.
